Invitation to Participate

Timeless celebrates the enduring essence of art, exploring how certain creations transcend time and cultural boundaries to remain relevant across generations. The concept of "Timeless" captures the idea that some works of art are not bound to their historical context but continue to speak to the human soul with universal power.

Think of Michelangelo's captivating sculptures, whose perfection and emotional depth have lasted through the centuries; Leonardo da Vinci's paintings, which continue to inspire entire generations; or Wassily Kandinsky's works, whose abstract and innovative language revolutionized art and still influences contemporary artists.

Throughout every era, artists have created works that defy time, from the majestic temples of antiquity to the revolutionary masterpieces of the Renaissance, to the bold expressions of modern art. In this virtual exhibition, we invite you to explore the concepts expressed through your art and see how these works can transcend contexts while maintaining their uniqueness over time.

This event aims to promote and elevate art on an international level, creating a meeting point for free and creative minds. We invite artists from all backgrounds to participate in this collective celebration with no specific theme.

The selected works will be exhibited for 30 days in MuVi, the ex-independent virtual museum of Rome, now part of the Make Art Gallery artistic group. This online gallery, without avatars and registrations, has four interconnected rooms, accessible via the web. The virtual gallery is not a video, but a professionally curated exhibition space that can be visited during the event dates through an internet browser on PCs, Smartphones, and Tablets at www.makeartgallery.com

Eligibility: Participation is open to all artists, with no age or nationality restrictions. All forms of visual art are welcome, including painting, photography, digital art, and video art.

Theme: The exhibition theme is open. It is the task of Make Art Gallery to find the infinite within your works.

What the exhibition includes:

- 30-day exhibition, accessible 24/7 from smartphones, tablets, and computers
- High-resolution exhibition poster
- Over 100 high-definition photos taken in the gallery, available for download
- Digital printable participation certificate
- High-definition catalog of the exhibited works (available as a downloadable PDF or viewable in the gallery)
- We will invite art lovers, collectors, and curators to visit the exhibition.

Awards: This exhibition is not a competition in the traditional sense but a collective experience designed to promote emerging art in modern contexts. For each exhibition, we grant recognition to artists who stand out for originality and expressive quality, based on votes from an artistic jury and the Make Art Gallery committee.

First Prize "Timeless 2024": Creation and publication of an "Art e-book," an artistic monograph dedicated to the winning artist. This professional art catalog will be distributed on major online platforms, such as Amazon Kindle, Kobo Books, Apple Books, Google Play Books, Mondadori Store, Hoeppli, and more. The artist will have the opportunity to share the catalog with collectors and gallery owners, enhancing the prestige of their presentation through international distribution and amplifying the visibility of their works. The catalog will be available for free on all listed platforms, allowing a broad audience to download and read it on eReaders or mobile devices, thus expanding the artist's reach.

Second Prize "Art Critique": One or more artists, selected by the artistic jury and the Make Art Gallery committee, will receive the "Art Critique" prize for "Timeless 2024," which includes free participation in the next virtual group exhibition and a certificate of artistic merit in digital printable format.

All participating artists will receive a digital printable certificate of participation via email.

How to Participate: Interested artists must submit a maximum of 5 works in digital format (JPEG, PNG, TIFF). Each work must be accompanied by the Title, Technique, Dimensions, and Year of creation. The works will be evaluated by an artistic jury and the Make Art Gallery committee, with special attention to new expressive trends. Only selected artists will be contacted within a few days of submission or shortly after the selection process ends.

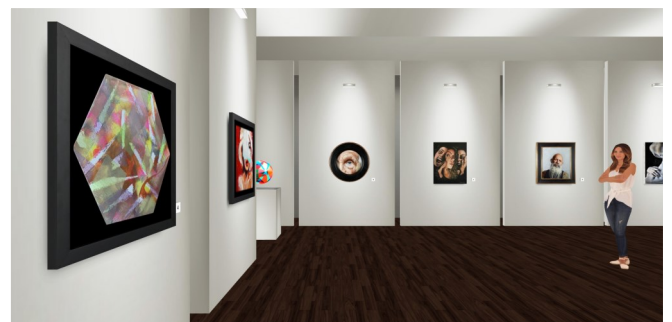
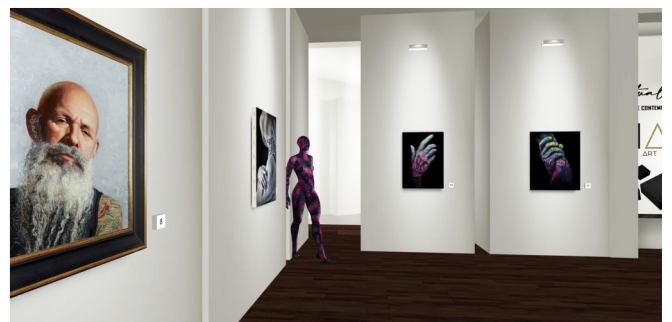
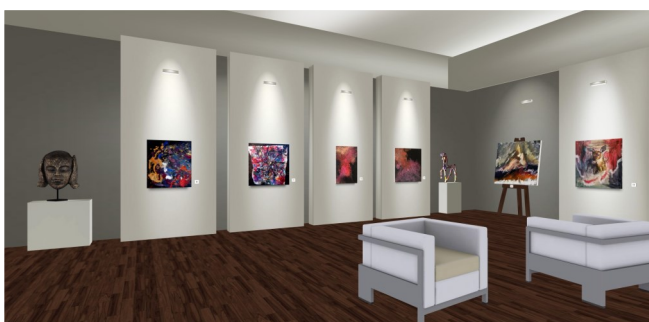

Selection and Participation Fees: Participation in the selection phase is free. Once selected, artists can choose to proceed by paying a contribution of 20 euros for one artwork or 30 euros for two artworks. Confirmation of the selected works will be sent in the welcome email.

Deadlines and Details: The deadline for submitting applications is October 27, 2024. The event is scheduled for the first week of November 2024, with the official dates to be announced at the end of the selection process.
